Organizational Charter

Article 1 Name & Purpose

Section 1.1 Name

The Name of the Organization shall be CHEO of Greater Knoxville Area

Section 1.2 Purpose

The purpose of complementary Health Education Organization (CHEO) shall be to promote education in, and to foster awareness and understanding of complementary and natural health care practice in our community.

Section 1.3 Non-Profit Status

Complementary health Education Organization is a Non-profit association organized exclusively for educational purposes under section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code.

Section 1.4 Limitations

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not, except to insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purpose of this organization.

Article 2 Carrying out the Purpose

Section 2.1 Meetings

Monthly educational meetings open to the public will be held. Other educational events such as workshops, seminars, conventions, and health fairs will be offered to the community intermittently.

Section 2.2 Meeting Focus

The focus of all meetings and educational events will be to carry out the organization's purpose by featuring holistic/natural healthcare practitioners who will educate/demonstrate their specialty area. Topics presented shall not imply endorsement by the Complementary Health Education Organization and CHEO does not make any specific claims regarding uses or benefits of a healing modality.

Article 3 Organization membership

Section 3.1 General membership

Membership is open to those practitioners and persons interested in complementary and natural health care practices.

Section 3.2 Duties and Responsibilities of Members

Membership or leadership in this organization does not serve as qualifying evidence of any level of proficiency or ability relating to provision of health care services and shall not be so represented.
